Currently underway at Newquay Cornwall Airport is a £3 million Terminal expansion set for completion this year.

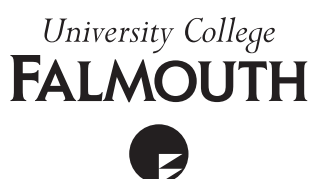
The airport expansion includes:

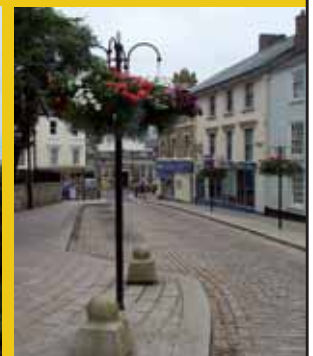

Transforming Cornwall Through IT

actnow – the story so far...

actnow started in April 2002, the first ever broadband partnership between the public and private sectors and one of the largest such partnerships in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly since it was granted Objective One status by the European Union in 2000.

Led by Cornwall Enterprise and including more than £7 million investment from Objective One, **actnow** was set up to spearhead the development of broadband amongst businesses in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly. The project is part financed by the European Union through the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) and the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund (EAGGF). Other project partners include BT, the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, the South West of England Regional Development Agency, Cornwall County Council, Business Link Devon and Cornwall, and Cornwall College.

By the end of March 2006, broadband coverage in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly reached 99%. All 100 exchanges in the county now have broadband available.

More than 8,000 businesses in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly had connected to broadband.

3,600 businesses received free ICT-related business advice from an **actnow** advisor at their premises to help them make the most of their broadband connection and the latest technology.

1,600 businesses spent a total of £4.6 million on IT investments, supported by subsidies from **actnow accelerator**.

350 farms in Cornwall connected to broadband and 100 farms invested a total of £71,000 in developing their ICT infrastructure.

The economic impact: It is estimated that nearly 3,000 jobs have been created and that Cornwall's GDP has benefited by about £73 million.

actnow – what's next?

Already 40% of businesses in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly have broadband – well ahead of the national average. **actnow** is aiming for 50%.

actnow has coordinated the roll-out of a number of strategically located wireless broadband hotspots, so you're never more than 10 minutes from broadband access in Cornwall.

'Some would say the new killer application for broadband is that it allows people to work flexibly from the office, at home and on the move.'

actnow is working on a pilot study called **actnow flex** to examine the productivity gains associated with flexible working.

actnow wants to ensure that Cornwall's businesses make the most of the very latest super-fast broadband.

actnow is working to maximise the environmental benefits of broadband – created for example through less business travel, less paper use and less office space.

actnow is working to maximise the social benefits of broadband use – improved accessibility for people with disabilities and better access to skills training.

actnow wants to help bridge the 'digital divide' between those who have internet access and those who do not.

'Ultimately, actnow wants to help all businesses and individuals in Cornwall fulfil their potential – thus improving our local economy and quality of life for all.'

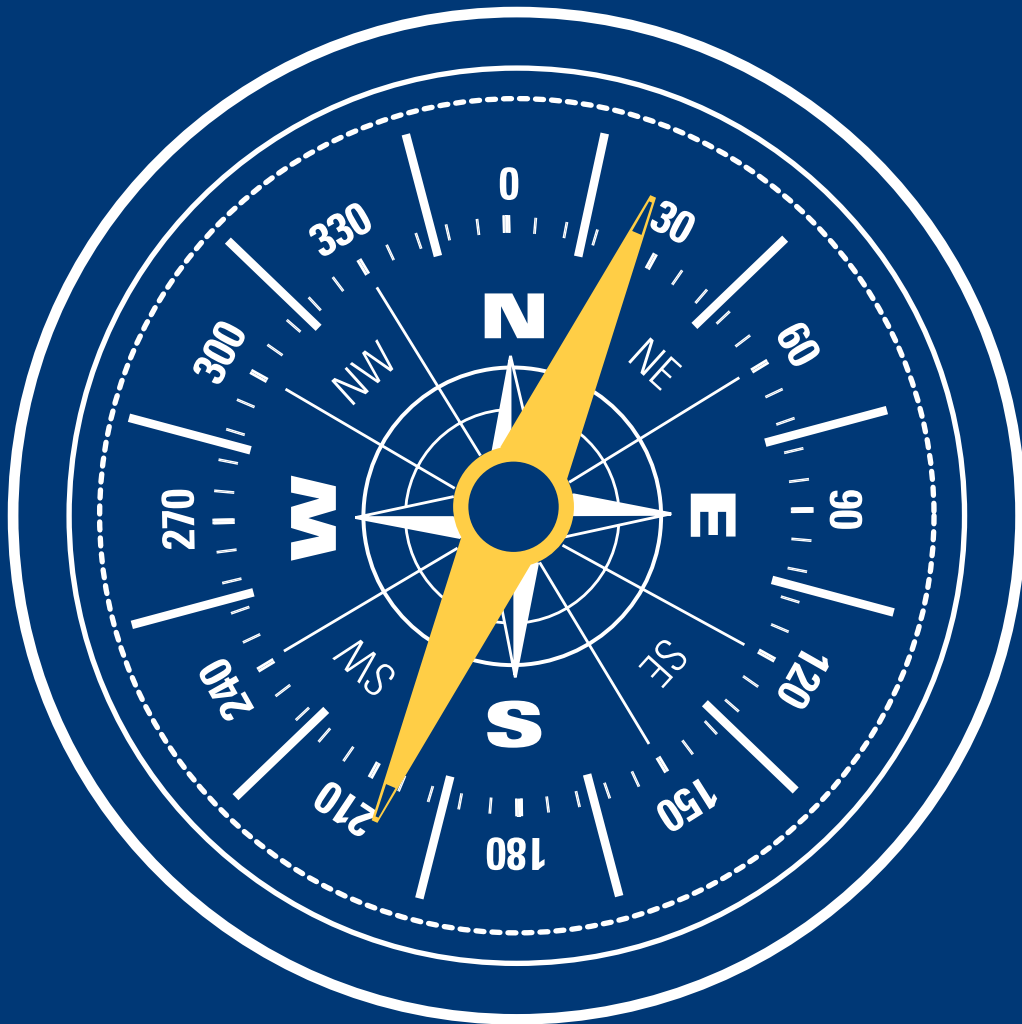

Objective One Partnership

Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly qualified for the European Objective One Programme because its GDP (a measure of wealth creation in the workplace) was below the EU average.

Successes of the Objective One Programme include a higher percentage of businesses connected to Broadband than in the UK via



the actnow project. Other investment includes more than £60 million invested in the flagship Combined Universities in Cornwall and the Knowledge Spa; more than £26 million committed to more than £75 million worth of workspace; almost £50 million invested in business support; more than £21 million in training; more than £25 million into helping people into training and work; almost £3 million invested in Newquay Cornwall Airport and almost £25 million in supporting local produce.

The success so far is evident in the latest Office of National Statistics figures showing Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly wealth creation growing more rapidly than inner London.

The Objective Partnership office was put in place on behalf of the whole partnership – public private and community sectors – to communicate the Programme's aims and successes and signpost people and projects to information and assistance. The Partnership office is now also supporting the partnership to focus on the years ahead now that the next EU programme – Convergence – has been confirmed.
