Background

The East Riding of Yorkshire Council was formed in 1996 and is the largest unitary authority in England with an area of 2,415 square kilometres. In 2001 it had a population of 314,113.

The East Riding includes Holderness which with its 40 mile sweep of North Sea coastline between Flamborough Head and Spurn Point is the fastest eroding coastline in Europe. It encompasses the whole of the North Bank of the Humber Estuary outside the City of Hull and also the area around Goole south of the Ouse. The chalk escarpment of the Yorkshire Wolds runs in a crescent from the Humber to the sea at Flamborough Head, its



typical open rolling landscapes separating the agriculturally rich plain of Holderness to the East from the equally rich Vale of York to the West. The Western boundary of the East Riding through the Vale of York is formed by the River Derwent down to its confluence with the River Ouse, and then along the River Aire to Snaith.

The East Riding includes parts of the outer suburban development of Kingston upon Hull, including large areas of housing to the West and major industrial areas to the East. The major free standing towns are the coastal resort of Bridlington, the historic Minster Town of Beverley and the Port of Goole but there are many other smaller towns and villages scattered over its wide area.





Agriculture is the traditional mainstay employer. Although the numbers engaged in agriculture have declined in common with the rest of the country, it remains important. Intensive livestock production, particularly pigs and poultry, is of particular importance. However the East Riding is also a major industrial area with chemical, aerospace, caravan and joinery manufacturers. There is a major gas installation on the coast at Easington and the port related development at Goole has also been growing in recent years. Tourism is important. The East Riding has a rich historical heritage and traditional seaside holiday attractions. The Country's first factory retail outlet at Hornsea Freeport is a major day trip attraction.



Access for the Disabled

East Riding of Yorkshire Building Control Officers can advise on how to improve access and facilities for the disabled in existing buildings. From October 2004 owners of buildings accessed by the public and service providers will be required to have made permanent alterations to the physical fabric of their buildings. The purpose of the Disability Discrimination Act is to remove any features that make it impossible or unreasonably difficult for a disabled person to make use of a service.
