To create a strong retail, commercial and leisure destination...

An attractive mix of city working, living and learning is being created, supported by a diverse retail and leisure offering and improved connections between the City Centre and Waterfront.

A new Digital Village on the Kingsway will provide flexible office space within a high quality and vibrant commercial environment to support the growth of higher value, technology business activities, that will increasingly drive forward the wider Swansea Bay City Region economy.

This is complemented by a new leisure-led, mixed-use development planned for Swansea Central which will include

- a new Digital Arena for events and concerts and an outdoor Digital Square
- more retail to extend the City Centre's range of shops
- a boutique cinema, restaurants, cafés
- additional space for University offices
- a new hotel, residential apartments
- a broad pedestrian bridge to create a permanent link from the city to the waterfront

Additionally, the City Waterfront area is a landmark location that will become a new commercial and leisure destination in Swansea, in combination with additional residential and community uses.

Together, these developments will create a strong and vibrant digital city that will be the economic engine of the wider city region.

The Institute of Life Science based at Swansea University co-locates interdisciplinary research and development with state-of-the-art clinical research facilities and business incubation units, and is supporting the growth of a dynamic life science cluster.

A strong creative sector is developing which includes businesses such as iCreate, Waters Creative, Vibe TV and Netbop. Wales's first dedicated space built purely for use by the creative industries is located at Swansea's Urban Village development in the City Centre, providing an affordable and cutting-edge hub for small start-ups, creative companies and the performing arts.

Swansea has a burgeoning technology sector, with many new enterprises emerging to commercialise research and expertise in areas such as digital media and ICT; Swansea TechHub (one of only seven TechHubs around the world) and Indycube Swansea Central are thriving examples of new co-worker spaces supporting enterprising and innovative business activity.



Mae gan Abertawe sector technoleg ffyniannus, gyda llawer o fentrau newydd yn dod i'r amlwg i fasnacheiddio ymchwil ac arbenigedd mewn meysydd fel y cyfryngau digidol a TGCh; mae TechHub Abertawe (un o saith TechHub yn unig ar draws y byd) ac Indycube Abertawe Ganolog yn enghreifftiau ffyniannus o fannau newydd i gydweithwyr sy'n cefnogi gweithgarwch busnes blaengar ac arloesol.



Innovation

A new £31 million world-class Computational Science facility due to open at Swansea University in 2018 will place Swansea at the heart of a thriving regional ecosystem of digital companies and research.

Swansea is also a key hub for HPC Wales – an innovative collaboration between Welsh universities, Government and Fujitsu – which gives business and researchers access to world class, secure and easy to use high-performance computing technology, as well as the support and training necessary to fully exploit it.

University of Wales Trinity Saint David's ambitious campus development in SA1 Swansea Waterfront will create additional opportunities to engage with industry in open innovation and knowledge exploitation, and complement its cultural quarter in the city centre. The unique Construction Wales Innovation Centre (CWIC) is due to open at UWTSW Waterfront Innovation Quarter development and will offer state-of-the-art facilities and world-class training for individuals and construction companies.

SA1 Swansea Waterfront developing at the heart of the city

The University of Wales Trinity Saint David's new £300million SA1 Swansea Waterfront development is taking shape in the heart of the city. New facilities for the Faculty of Architecture, Computing and Engineering, Education and Communities as well as new library facilities are being created at the prime waterfront location.

The University's vision for SA1 Swansea Waterfront is for a neighbourhood with academic activity at its core to attract companies to collocate with the University to exploit knowledge, develop skills, support existing companies and attract new investment into the region.

The innovative development will include purpose-built facilities for learning, teaching and applied research, as well as social and recreational spaces for use by the University and wider community in the heart of the city centre.

New enterprise hubs will be created together with high skill accelerator schemes, to grow new businesses linked to the universities portfolio, to further develop the skills of current businesses and attract new investment into the region.

UWTSD Vice-Chancellor Professor Medwin Hughes, DL said: *"This is a £300 million investment into the heart of Swansea. Our ambition for SA1 Swansea Waterfront links directly to the strategic priorities for the city and the region. As Swansea's city University, we are working together to develop brand Swansea. A strong city is essential to establish a strong region and, as a University that has campuses across South West Wales, UWTSD is well placed to deliver the connectivity needed to ensure that the benefits are manifest across the Swansea Bay City Region."*

Over the past 5 years, UWTSD has, and continues to invest over £100 million of its own resources into the heart of Swansea to provide opportunities for local people and companies to access high skills development in key priority areas for the region; and to utilise those skills for the benefit of the region. The University's strategy links with the ambitions for the region by providing the support system and skills pipeline to deliver economic impact that will lead ultimately to jobs.

At the launch of the commencement of the building work, Ken Skates, Economy and Infrastructure Secretary for the Welsh Government said:

"This exciting development has the potential to transform this part of Swansea. I am particularly impressed by University of Wales Trinity Saint David's determination to engage with the business community and local people to ensure the benefits of this development are felt across the City."

Bydd y datblygiad arloesol yn cynnwys cyfleusterau pwrpasol ar gyfer dysgu, addysgu ac ymchwil cymhwysol, ynghyd â mannau cymdeithasol a hamdden i'w defnyddio gan y Brifysgol a'r gymuned ehangach yng nghanol y ddinas.

Bydd canolfannau menter newydd yn cael eu creu ynghyd â chynlluniau sbarduno â sgiliau lefel uchel, er mwyn meithrin busnesau newydd yn gysylltiedig â phortffolio'r Brifysgol, datblygu sgiliau busnesau cyfredol ymhellach a denu buddsoddiad newydd i'r ardal.

Meddai Is-Ganghellor Y Drindod Dewi Sant, yr Athro Medwin Hughes, DL: *"Dyma fuddsoddiad £300 miliwn yng nghanol Abertawe. Mae ein huchelgais ni ar gyfer SA1 Glannau Abertawe yn cysylltu'n uniongyrchol â'r blaenoriaethau strategol ar gyfer y ddinas a'r rhanbarth. Fel Prifysgol ddinesig Abertawe, rydym ni'n gweithio gyda'n gilydd i ddatblygu brand Abertawe. Mae dinas gadarn yn hanfodol er mwyn sefydlu rhanbarth cadarn, a gan ein bod ni'n Brifysgol sydd â champysau ar draws de-orllewin Cymru, mae'r Drindod Dewi Sant mewn sefyllfa gref i ddarparu'r cysylltiadau sydd eu hangen er mwyn sicrhau bod y buddion i'w gweld ar draws Dinas-Ranbarth Bae Abertawe."*

- build on the extensive industrial links that exist across the UWTSO Group, which includes Coleg Sir Gâr and Coleg Ceredigion.

Our art galleries display a broad spectrum of visual arts, exhibiting work of grand masters and contemporary artists. The newly-refurbished Glynn Vivian Art Gallery's exhibitions programme brings the work of today's artists alive with its sharp, contemporary overview of the arts in a local, national and international context.

The Brangwyn Hall and Grand Theatre provide exciting programmes of live events and an eclectic mix of performances.

The Dylan Thomas Centre hosts a unique exhibition about our much-loved poet and co-ordinates an annual Dylan Thomas Festival of literary events; the annual International Dylan Thomas Prize attracts world-wide entries from some of the best young literary writers in the English language.

Many cultural events including the Wales National Air Show, Street Food Festival and the Swansea International Festival of classical music and arts are held across Swansea.

Swansea Market is a wonderfully welcoming place for shoppers, with quality local produce and souvenirs. The Market has been recognised nationally as 2015 Great Britain Best Large Indoor Market.

Swansea has a Purple Flag award for the quality of its night-time economy; the lively Wind Street lunch and night-time experience – an irresistible mix of restaurants, cafés and bars – is a must visit.

Premier League football and European rugby are played at the city's Liberty Stadium.

Swansea University hosted the 2014 IPC Athletics European Paralympic Championships, and the city is home to the famous Swansea Harriers, British Athletics Club of the Year in 2014.

The Wales National Pool is a world-class centre for aquatic sport, and was a key training venue for the 2012 London Olympics.

The 2014 European Dart 18 Sailing Championships were held in Swansea, and Llangennith beach on Gower has been named one of the top six UK surf spots (*The Daily Telegraph*).

There is plenty to encourage participation in sport and leisure in Swansea:

- Swansea LC – houses Wales' largest waterpark and gymnasium, 30ft climbing wall, multi-purpose double sports hall, a luxury Spa, an interactive fitness area for children, and an indoor surf simulator;
- 360 Beach and Watersports – a multi-sport facility, offering qualified instructor-led sessions in kayaking, stand up paddle boarding, powerkiting, beach volleyball and other beach-based activities;
- Magnificent links golf courses with spectacular views over beaches and bays;
- Swansea Half Marathon – officially the UK's best half marathon.



Connectivity

With its connections to the wider transport network, Swansea is strategically located to access the UK, Europe and beyond.

Swansea is linked to London and the South East via the M4, and to the Midlands and the North via the M50 and M5. Swansea is also part of the national coach network with direct express services to the rest of Wales, Central London, major airports and other parts of the UK. Swansea is located on the Great Western Mainline to London and has links to all the UK's main cities.

Cardiff Airport is less than an hour's drive away, offering a range of flights to European cities and beyond. There is also a small airport located at Fairwood on Gower handling light aircraft and private planes.

The port of Swansea is ideally placed for maritime trade with north-west Europe, Ireland and the Mediterranean. Owned and operated by Associated British Ports, the port caters for ships up to 30,000 tonnes and is equipped with a wide range of heavy-duty modern cargo handling equipment.

Digital connectivity is growing:

- Broadband coverage (Next Generation Access NGA) is available to 96% of Swansea premises
- Fibre broadband is available for around 80% of premises offering speeds of up to 80mbps
- Swansea is among the first locations in the UK to benefit from ultrafast broadband which is capable of maintaining speeds up to 1Gbps
- BT's ultrafast broadband test lab allows academic researchers, start-ups and other communications providers to trial new technologies and applications that exploit the higher speeds provided by 'G.fast' /ultrafast broadband






Average annual full-time earnings

Residents qualified to degree level or higher (NVQ 4)




Residents qualified to A-Level (NVQ 3)


